# TOWN LIST OF UNIVERSAL MACHINE CANCELS

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Methodology, Thanks, and Dedication This town list began with covers and information provided first by Bart Billings in the early 1992, expanded by my own search for Ohio covers in the local dealer dollar boxes, and then added to with help from Reg Morris in 2004. Earlier Reg had sold me his portable collection of machines . . . a Perfection hand stamper, and a Universal Model K. The local post office emptied its basement of three electric machines.

I now had machines and the covers they produced.

Reg was most obliging to add notes and arrows to his covers in light pencil, which proved invaluable in my research.

This huge collection of Ohio covers was first separated by year, pre-1920 and then post-1920. The pre-1920 covers were arranged by machine. The post-1920 machines were arranged by town name in alphabetical order. It became obvious over time that I had arranged and identified the covers incorrectly. Bob Payne at this time was a great source of articles for Machine Cancel Forum, which I served as Editor. In between articles I would pester him for help in identifying covers, as well as ask if my cover was a new date of use. He eventually just sent me his computer list which included the Universal electric machines, and told me to enjoy, on condition that as I received it free, it be shared with Machine Cancel Society members for free so long as their use generated more articles for Forum. Bob's concept was very clear . . . share and publish. The more you share, the more you will have to publish. That is why this list is free, and you are in return asked to share your finds by scanning them and sending them off to me, as Editor.

The list of Model K's – the Universal hand powered machine – came from Bart Billings, which he also freely shared and which he earlier published through the Machine Cancel Society as Anthology III. It seemed curious at the time that Bob did not furnish me with the hand powered Universal listing, nor the HD2 International hand powered, but looking back it was because the better source was Bart. Besides publishing the Anthology III on the Universal Model K, Bart published two books on the HD2 International hand powered machine.

Reg's and Bart's Ohio covers are the rock of this town list, with Bob's list providing the structure, and Bart's list of Model K giving it the final touch.

It is to Bart, Bob, and Reg the thanks belong, and this Ohio Town List of Universal Machine Cancels is dedicated to the trio.

The Machine Cancel Society through the hard work of Gary Carlson maintains a state data base. That list was <u>not</u> incorporated into this one, but instead used to check data ONLY when there seemed to be a problem. It also permitted the publication of Bob's list, updated only by finds which I could personally confirm.

YES! This list will be updated by <u>your</u> reports, and the Society database – but only from scans and photocopies that you provide.

# Ohio Town List

# Welcome!

By now you have read the hand out material contained in the

March 2008 Issue of Machine Cancel Forum. By this time you are familiar with machine cancels -- how we identify them, how we catalog the postmarks and the cancels, how to distinguish Universal machine cancels from other cancels, and are ready to begin searching for new Ohio towns that used Universal machine cancels and new dates of use for those towns that are already recorded as having Universal machines. It is the hope of the Editor and the Machine Cancel Society that you will join in the chase, and consider joining the Society. Annual dues are relatively inexpensive . . . \$15 per year, and this entitles you to four issues of Machine Cancel Forum every year. The range of topics discussed in Machine Cancel Forum is great, and range from the very modern to the very old. The goal is to not only meet your current machine cancel needs, but to encourage you to grow into other machine cancel collecting areas.

# Value?

Up to now we have not spoken or reviewed any hand out material on

values. Because these dates of use and towns on the list are based on reported examples not post office records, value cannot be assigned based upon length of use for each listing or even number of examples reported. The number of reporters and the overall census is just not large enough to do this. Age is also not a determining factor. Sometimes it just seems easier to find the older material than the newer simply because more of it was saved. In the future it is hoped that a value system can be assigned, using factors such as population of the community that used the machine cancel and a factor of hardness in finding postal history of the age in question. For right now, most of the machine cancels in this list are priced in the market place based upon general qualities of value (postal rate, age v modern, frequency of such material being found, type of mailing – postal card, picture post card, large size envelope, cut 2x4) and often times ignore the machine cancel aspect. Some of the items found on the Ohio list were very hard to find, and were found on cut 2 x 4 paper for mere pennies. While a nicely preserved number six envelope is to be preferred, a 2 x 4 cut to size example is just as good as verifying dates of use as the larger piece.

# The List - The list is arranged alphabetically. As noted in your material

before, the Universal machines were manufactured to be either electric or hand powered. If you are confused about identifying hand powered machines, see the March 2008 Special Issue of Forum for help. In this list, they are identified as Model K. You will find pictures showing the different types of machine cancels, and occasionally even examples of other machines. Many towns switched from one make of machine to another. It is impossible to 'flag' every change. But you will find examples in the list to help remind you of the different manufacturers. A typical listing is featured below:

This is a listing for Terrace Park, Ohio. On the very first line you will observe that a Model K is reported used in 1957, starting July 5 (0705, the month-day is given numerically) and ending December 18 (1218). Remember the Model K is a hand powered machine, and the postmark dial and cancellation are very close together. Again review the March 2008 Special Issue of Machine Cancel Forum if you can not distinguish this kind of machine.

The second and third line for Terrace Park do not list a model, and that means these cancels are from electric machines. On the third line for Terrace Park you will see "45174". This is the zip code that appears in the postmark dial.

The postmark dial and cancel types are charted on the following page. Occasionally in the list, you will find quick reminders of these types.

Finally, to the right of the postmark dial and cancel types you will find additional single digit numbers. The starting list was prepared by Robert Payne ("Bob" to his many friends). Because these cancels were applied by metal dies, these dies frequently changed. When they changed, letters were recut or a new type of wavy cancel was installed. Even when their designs were of the same type, Bob tracked the changes of dies. He numbered his discoveries 1, 2, 3, etc. Where he predicted a change in die or a much earlier use of an older die, you will find a number 2 or 3, without a predecessor. For example, in the Terrace Park example you will find on lines 2 and 3 of the listing a "2" to the right of the cancel type, 300. In Bob's study of Terrace Park, his report is short for the years 1958-1962. What was used during this period of time? Was it a longer use of the hand powered Model K? Or perhaps an earlier use of the electric? Or even still, could another style or type of machine have been used? The "2" is there as a flag that something preceded the 1963 electric use, and to be on the watch for it!

There are various ways for the town name (as well as machine number and station if applicable) to be engraved on the dial. To describe how the town name (and machine number and/or station name if applicable) are engraved inside the dial, **add these letters** to the Type above:

TS	=	Town and State at top of dial
SB	=	Town and State at top of dial; station name at bottom



ST = Town and State at bottom of dial; station name is at the top
B = Town and State at top of dial; branch name at bottom
1R = The machine number 1 appears in the dial, to the right
1L = The machine number 1 appears in the dial, to the left

Town only at top of dial, state name at bottom

Example: If we wished to describe a Type D dial with the machine number "6" inside at the right, with a station name at the top, and town-state at the bottom, it would be described as Type DST6L.

#### UNIVERSAL Cancellation Types Used in Ohio



In those situations were a line is purposely engraved short, the number of the line (counting from the bottom) is added to the three-digit type. For example, on page 124 is the listing for the Toledo, Central Station. The cancel types are listed as 201 and 2012. Both are 7 wavy line cancels like Type 200. But for cancel type 201, the bottom line is engraved short at the left. For cancel type 2012, both the bottom line and the line immediately above it are engraved shorter at the left than the top five lines. See page 4 in the Ohio list for scan of an Akron Type 2012 cancellation.

#### HINT # 1: Some Quick Look-Alikes for a Universal Machine Cancel:

An International cancel with an International Type J dial . . . see page 53 in the Ohio Town List for a scan of an International Type J dial.

A comparison of: Columbia-Ielfield, International Model HD 2 hand powered machine, and a Universal Model K hand powered machine . . . see page 57 in the Ohio Town List.

HINT #2: Can't tell an electric Universal from a hand-powered? See page 12 in the Ohio Town List. The key is the distance from the postmark to the cancel.



Compare the "A" of AKRON in Die 1 and 2. On the example above, the enclosed area at the top of the "A" is small. On the example at right, the area is large.





But as shown in the inserted box, Dial Die 1 was used intermittently thereafter. The study of die changes is challenging if examples are not plentiful.

Die differences are indicated with a number that follows the assigned catalog type.



1. Several examples were found with worn dials from early 1934, used with the Type 600 cancellation. It is likely that this represents a continuation of the 1927-1928 dies. (This needs to be verified by comparing these 1934 uses with the 1927-1928 uses.)



**At left:** 1934 0604 usage. Type DT 600. Note the wear in the postmark dial. You may also wish to note the E of BELLEFONTAINE. The lower bar of E is very short. It does *not* match later dies used from 1937-1965.

2. In late 1934, a new dial is observed. The letters of BELLEFONTAINE are small, and match the metal postmark dial used from 1937-1951.




At left: 1934 1119 usage. Type DT 600. This is a new postmark die of the same style as previously noted. This 1934 postmark die matches the 1937-1965 postmark die, but uses an earlier cancellation die (with only one full wave in its cancellation).

Because the November 1934 postmark dials match the 1937 dials, Bob Payne's die listing identification with a "1" next to the catalog type is kept. As more dials are compared, recorded and added to the listing, the number listing for the dies will be changed so they run consecutive from the very first DT dial used at Bellefontaine to the very last.

In 1937 it is observed that the 1934 new postmark die is used with a new cancellation die at Bellefontaine. The 1937 cancellation die is also of a different style. Instead of having only one full wave in its cancellation, the 1937 cancellation die has two full waves. Hence the 1937 cancellation die is identified as a new type for Bellefontaine . . . Type 300.

In comparing the three Bellefontaine Dials above, you will note that the 1944 and 1956 postmarks are produced by Universal machines. However, the 1962 example is from an International machine. In comparing the two, you will note that the pre-Zip Code Universal dials have <u>no</u> comma after the city name. On the other hand, the International pre-Zip Code dial has a comma, and it is rather large. You will also note that the metal slug for the year is much larger for the Universal dial in comparison to the International year.

It is also noteworthy that the metal dies that produced the 1944 and 1956 examples are different. The 1944 and 1956 examples are of the same style, and both cataloged as Type DT. The 1944 example has smaller engraving, and you will note that the B and E of Bellefontaine are directly opposite each other at the 9-o'clock and 3-o'clock positions. But the 1956 example (with the larger lettering) has the B and E dropped below these positions. A straight line has been drawn across the diameter of the 1944 and 1956 dials, and you can compare the positioning of the lettering.

Bob Payne did his best to observe and record these die differences, and to leave notes that another die may have been used but not reported. Both the 1944 and 1956 examples used a Type 300 wavy-line cancel, which Bob noted in his data base

From late 1914 to the end of 1916, the Bellevue Universal used a different postmark dial, referred to by Bob Payne as Die 2. The information is arranged the same as Die 1, hence both are cataloged as Type BT. Die 2 lettering is noticeably different. Die 1's first E in BELLEVUE has almost equal length bars. But Die 2's first E has a much shorter middle bar. What was used in early to mid 1914? Examples will be needed to complete the record.

Starting in 1918, a smaller postmark dial is used, Type 300, with a 6-wavy line cancel with two full waves is found used in Bellevue, to 1959, according to Bob Payne with a significant gap in the record from 1922 to 1936. Newly found is a 6-wavy line cancel with but one full wave. It is listed as Type DT 600, and featured below:

The post office in 1951 installed a slogan onto the Universal machine at Bellevue to mark the community's centennial.



In 1959, an International machine cancel was installed at the Bellevue Post Office, and for a short time, both the International and Universal machines were used.





#### **BLUE ASH**

BLUE ASH DT 300 2 1952 1016 1956 0409 Blue Ash was an independent post office near Cincinnati. The Blue Ash post office was established in 1887, and absorbed into the Cincinnati administration in 1957. Note the single digit 2 in the cancellation listing. Is there an earlier cancellation die used prior to 1952? The listing by Bob Payne suggests we should look for one. It would be the same style as the 1952-1956 cancellation die, in that there are six wavy lines and two full waves. But the other cancellation die might have thinner lines OR some other distinguishing characteristic. There is a hint here to keep a watchful eye!





Figure 2: Universal Machine Cancel Ty	pe DT1L 300 used 1920 0103

This cancel 'looks like' a Universal machine cancel. The purpose of the tagging placed on the postage stamps was for a facer-canceller (FC) machine – quite unlike a Universal – to be able to 'see' the stamp and cancel it. None of the August 1, 1963, first day covers utilize a cancel that 'looks like' a facer-canceller. The interchangeability of machine cancel dies complicates the question. Is this example a FC cancel produced by traditional Universal machine cancel dies installed on the FC? Or was the FC unavailable on August 1, 1963, and a Universal machine cancel used for the first day covers? Compare with the cancel that follows.







Is there one wave or two? As a hint, do not just look at the top wavy line, study the bottom line as well! As you look at the top line of the 1932 example above, it seems to go up. But that is more of an illusion caused by the postmark dial resting high in its die space (it was not fully pressed down into the cancellation hub). But when you look at the bottom line of the 1932 example above, it clearly goes down and has but one full wave in its cancellation.









A most interesting machine cancel is found for Kent from 1974-1975. What appeared to be a Universal dial was accompanied by a machine marking that is common to machine cancels produced by a facer – canceller machine, like a Pitney-Bowes Mark II or similar facer-canceller device.

Reg Morris wrote about these Kent markings. He also found a similar marking on a 1960 Los Angeles machine, also a Universal. The markings are farther from the dial than are normally found on a facer canceller cancel. Could these be older facer-canceller machines sent to Los Angeles and Kent? Could these be engraving errors on the cancellation hubs (which produce the cancellation and hold the postmark dial)? Or are these Universal dies forced onto another manufacturer's machine?



Above, only **Figure 1** is confirmed to be produced by an early facer-canceller machine. Note the pair of trail bars used. **Figures 2, 3, and 4** have a single trail bar, and quite a distance from the postmark dial in comparison to the machine in **Figure 1**. What caused these markings on the Los Angeles and Kent machines? Was a non-Universal cancellation hub forced onto a Universal machine, and the mismatch caused a stray line of ink to print? Or were these early facer-canceller machines placed into later service at Los Angeles and Kent, being used with the local Universal postmark dial? Or is there another reason for these marks?

Many thanks to Reg Morris for discovering these items, and bringing them to collectors' attention.

#### **KENTON**

"The earliest known use of Universal machines was in Washington, D.C., and in New York (Hudson Terminal), in 1909." Bart Billings, A History of Postmarking Machines Used in Ohio (Ohio Postal History Society 1982) at page 32. Bob Payne describes these uses as trials, for purposes of testing various models. Billings, Payne, & Morris, A Primer – US Machine Postal Markings (2005) at pages 183-192. As a result of experiments and trials, sixty improved Universal Model B machines were installed during the period July 1, 1910, to June 30, 1913. Among the first twenty-five to be installed was the Universal at Kenton, Ohio. Bart Billings, Universal Stamping Machine Co – Machines and Postal Markings (Revision #2 October 1994), Appendix F.

Among Ohio Universal cancels, the bar cancel Universal Type 100 is unique to Kenton.








**At left:** Mount Sterling 1942 0601

Note: The Mount Sterling post office opened in 1830. For a good many years, its growth was slow. It had a population of 1623 in 1980 and 1647 in 1990. It seems an unlikely place for machine cancel changes and innovations. But it is located in Madison County off I-71 and southwest of Columbus by about a half-hours drive from the Columbus outer-belt. With new freeways, it is close enough for a suburban commute. It is noteworthy that one of those machines in 1990 (with International characteristics) would utilize a postmark dial with a zip+4 number: 43143-9998. For Ohio, the Mount Sterling zip+4 postmark dial is unique. Why the zip+4 in the dial? By the mid-1990's it became apparent that with the United States Postal Service (USPS) mandating interchangeable cancelling hubs and postmark dies between machine manufacturer that identification of machines by looking at the final product (ie. the cancel) alone would be difficult if not impossible. Records and physical check of the post office for machine identification becomes necessary for positive identification. A Chamberlain machine cancel is known for Mount Sterling during this period of time, and reported by John Becker III. Because of the Mount Sterling zip+4 postmark dial, we were in effect warned by the change in the postmark that something different was being used there. This is not the case for other post-1990 postmarks whether they be Universals OR Internationals. For a real surprise, see the section for the Warren Universal machine cancel.







The Ohio River Canalization commemorative stamp was issued on October 19, 1929, at Cincinnati, Ohio, and various other cities along the Ohio River from Indiana to Pennsylvania, plus Washington, DC. No other Ohio city was an official cite. So is this an unofficial first day of use? The United States Post Offices –Volume V – The Ohio Valley by Richard W. Helbock lists the Norwood post office as closing in 1892. The Directory of Post Offices by the Postmark Collector's Club lists Norwood as a branch of

Cincinnati. Despite the incorporation of Norwood's postal operations into Cincinnati, Norwood is an independent city of 23000 with its own mayor and city council. The city's official web site states, "Rich in pride, tradition and heritage, the City of Norwood, Ohio has long thrived as an independent community nestled in the heart of the Greater Cincinnati metropolitan area." So is it an unofficial city? Yes, but it is better described as an official branch first day cover!









Sandusky received an American Flag cancel device in 1898, and used it at its main post office until 1913, which included the use of the Perry's Victory slogan flag. A Columbia slogan marking Perry's Victory was also briefly used in 1913, followed by a Columbia 8-bar cancel to 1918. It would appear from the table that the Universal was tried in 1919.

From 1920, the work horse at the Sandusky main post office has been the International electric machines.

Cedar Point has been a busy station for Sandusky. It started with a Columbia cancel in 1922. It too used an American Flag cancel device, with the first installation in 1927 without a designation of its station status (or 'blind use' as it is called). From 1927-1934, the appropriate station designation appeared in the flag itself. As can be seen from the chart below, a Universal device was used. Bob Payne notes a large dial in 1948. The Editor has not seen this dial.

**Nippon Electric Company (N.E.C.)**: The NEC in Warren used the WARREN, OH 444 Universal postmark dial and cancel hub with Warren's PRAY / FOR / PEACE slogan. Since the metal dies that impress the postmark and cancel are the exact same metal dies used on the Universal, the two machine cancels can ONLY be distinguished by date of use.




**Above:** Former Warren Model G, in storage with the Editor, seen from the operator's side.

Above: The Editor in bliss, discovering a new machine cancel in Warren, the Nippon Electric Company (NEC). It uses the old Universal metal dies previously used in Warren. The NEC uses air pressure to pull the mail through the canceller. It can get quite dusty if the air filter is not regularly cleaned. The machine is observed in August 2001, and was tested with 2001 income tax returns the April before. Because of maintenance requirements, its use was irregular. When observed in August 2001, the machine cancel dial was dated JUL 6 / 2001 PM.



**Above:** Regular use of the **Model G Universal machine cancel** with PRAY / FOR / PEACE slogan ceased October 2, 1998. The Model G was in a poor state of repair and operation was difficult. The slogan barely prints. 1999 year slugs were not received.



**Above:** In 2000, the Warren Post Office received a 2000 year slug *and a new NEC cancelling device*. The NEC sat in its box until 2001, when it was made operational to cancel April 15, 2001, tax filings. What is featured to the left above is a last souvenir cancel **from the old Model G Universal, February 16, 2000**. To the right above is another souvenir, with inverted dial. Whether the invert was intentional or not was not disclosed.



**Above:** July 6, 2001, **NEC use of Warren's Universal postmark dial and slogan cancel** hub. Because the metal dies that imprint the postmark and cancel are the same, regardless of whether the dies are inserted into a Model G Universal or NEC device, the final product looks the same! The NEC can use other metal dies as well. Therefore identification is by date of use. As when applied by the Universal Model G, the slogan is weak on this NEC applied cancel. This favor cancel was applied to the back of mail so the elements could be seen.

After July 6, 2001, the NEC in Warren has not been used other than:

April 15, 2002; April 15, 2003; April 15, 2004: and, April 15, 2006,

and all examples used the Model G Universal Warren postmark dial and the Universal PRAY / FOR /PEACE slogan. Unless a mailer specifically asked for an example, the NEC cancels appear exclusively on tax filing envelopes and for purposes of cleaning the dies when mail would be backstamped by the NEC.
